For Twication Planning and Traveling

Calling Between Countries

When ready to begin advance-booking your lodgings, tours, or other Twication activities, you may need to call Twilight Saga Sites in another country.

US and Canadian Twilighters

Both the United States and Canada are members of the **North American Numbering Plan**. Thus, calling to book reservations at any of the sites in *Tour the Twilight Saga* (TTTS) **Books One, Two, or Three** is relatively painless for you.

US Twilighters can dial a Canadian Twilight Saga Site's phone number—**TTTS Book Two**—just as you would a long distance phone call to any other state within the US: **1 + the 3-digit city code** (aka area code) + the 7-digit **local phone number**. Long distance phone call charges remain the same as when calling a number within another US state, which means it may not be a long distance call.

The same is true for Canadian Twilighters calling US Twilight Saga Sites—**TTTS Books One, Three** and (some sites in) **Four**. Dial: **1 + the 3-digit area code** (aka city code) + the 7-digit **local phone number**. Long distance phone call charges remain the same as when calling a number within another Canadian province, which means it may not be a long distance call.

US and Canadian Twilighters calling foreign Twilight Saga Sites found in **TTTS Book Four**, however, need to investigate the **Foreign National Twilighters** links below.

Either of the websites below will walk you through how to dial a phone number in the US or Canada—or any *other* country—**from any country**. While on either of these websites, it's a good idea also to figure out how to call a number in your home country **from the country you'll be visiting**.

UK Twilighters

To call a number in the US or Canada *from* a phone in the UK:

- Dial **00** (the international access code when in the UK)
- Dial **1** (the country code for the US and Canada)
- Dial the US/Canadian 3-digit **area/city code** and 7-digit **local phone number**.

Example: To call **Twifoot Tours** in Forks (360-640-1725) from anywhere in the UK, dial **00-1-360-640-1725**.

To call a number in the UK *from* a phone in the US or Canada:

- Dial **011** (the international access code when in the US or Canada)
- Dial **44** (the country code for the UK)
- Dial the **UK number**—but, *skip the first zero (0)*

Example: To reach the Harry Potter WB Studio Tour Call Centre (0845 084 0900) when calling from the US or Canada, dial **011-44-845-084-0900**. Do not dial the "0" before **845**.

Phone Numbers Important For International Twilighting

★911 is the Emergency Number in the US *or* Canada (999 in the UK)

911 calls are free from all US/Canadian pay phones and cell phones. The call will be answered by a trained operator able to dispatch police, fire, or emergency medical services to your location.

Directory Assistance

411 is the number to dial while in the US or Canada to obtain assistance for finding a phone number within the US or Canada. **411 is *not* a free call.**

You can find most US or Canadian phone numbers **on the Internet**. If using a free Wi-Fi connection, there's no charge.

Operator Assistance

If you need help placing a phone call while in the US or Canada, dial **0** (zero) to reach a local operator, or **00** (two zeros) to reach a US or Canadian long distance operator. You may be charged for this call, depending on what kind of phone you're using.

Dial **155** to reach an international operator while in the US or Canada. This number is free if calling from a payphone, but charges may apply when using other phones.

★ When Twilighting Internationally, Program Your Phone's Address Book

With Your Country's Embassy and Consulate Information

When traveling in a foreign country, your country's Embassy or Consulate is your life-line in the event that your passport goes missing or you suffer some sort of catastrophic emergency.

No matter what kind of phone you end up using while on holiday, program it with the phone numbers and addresses of your country's nearest Embassy or Consulate. Additionally, **bookmark** the **Internet addresses** for your closest Embassies and Consulates on every web-accessing device you travel with.

What follows are Embassy/Consulate references helpful to *a few* Twilighters traveling to places identified in **TTTS Books One, Two, and Three**—sites in the US states of Washington and Oregon, or the Canadian province of British Columbia.

All Twilighters traveling to sites in TTTS Book Four must access your government's website to find the phone numbers and addresses for the Embassies and Consulates nearest to the locations you plan to visit: Twilight Saga Sites in the US states of California or Louisiana, in the countries of Brazil or Italy, and the like.
